What a Year!!!!.....

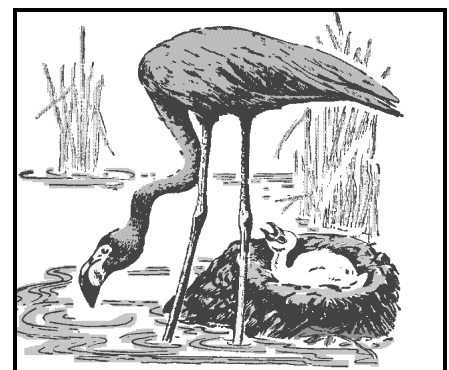
